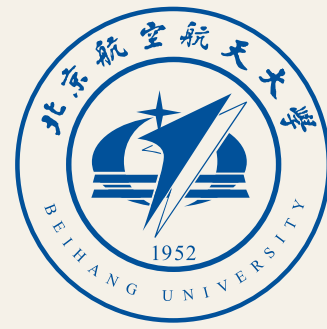

- ✓ Photo for documents

## Master's degree

- ✓ Bachelor's degree
- ✓ Language requirements are the same as for a bachelor's degree
- ✓ Academic transcript with grades
- ✓ Letters of recommendation (1-2 pieces)
- ✓ Medical certificate, certificate of no criminal record, international passport
